




Q6 Overall, how happy are you with flower beds in the Parish? (1 being very unhappy and 4 being very happy)




Q7 Are you aware of the 'Shincliffe Walks' leaflets?






Q9 Are you in favour of continuing sustainable, perennial planting in most other beds?





